MUTATION AFTER REGISTRATION OF SALE DEED/ORAL GIFT DEED (INSTRUCTION SLIP)

1. To apply for Mutation of leased property following documents are required to be submitted: -
 - a. Covering Letter requesting for mutation.
 - b. One photocopy of Sub lease/Sale/Conveyance/Oral Gift Deed duly attested by an Oath Commissioner & Court Fee Stamp of Rs. 2/- each.
 - c. 1 x photocopy of CNIC duly attested (of each party).
 - d. DHA Membership of Both the Parties (seller/buyers).
 - e. Two photographs duly attested of Transferee/Donee.
 - f. Photo Copy of Mutation Letter issued by the MEO to the transferee/Donee.
 - g. DHA's copy of Mutation letter issued by MEO.
 - h. Fresh Search Certificate from Sub Registrar office
 - i. Attested photocopy of any one of Sub Lease, B Lease or C Lease.
 - j. Rectification Deed duly attested – 1 Copy (If applicable)
 - k. NDC from Cantonment Board Clifton
 - l. Redemption Deed OR NOC from the respective Financial Institution duly attested -1 Copy (If applicable)
 - m. In case of Mutation of property in the name of more than one owner, a consent letter from all the co-sharers be attached, indicating/mentioning the address on which the correspondence be made
2. Once the application for mutation has been accepted please pay the fee in the Accts Branch (Complaint/Information Centre). The Accts Branch will make the necessary endorsement on the covering letter.
3. The applicant to deposit the application at the Reception Counter and obtain a receipt. The receipt will indicate the date of collection.
