3. **Visit of Foreign Guests.** As per SOP visit of foreign guests must be intimated along with copy of Passport minimum ten days prior to visit for clearance from concerned authorities. However, despite repeated reminders SOP is not being followed. Members are once again requested to kindly intimate Club minimum ten days prior to visit of foreign guests to avoid inconvenience.

4. **Correspondence with Club.** As per Club Rules only member can correspond with the Club. Member's rep can only correspond with the Club on behalf of member if he/she is authorized in black and white by the member.

5. **Guests Policy for Pirate's Den** Pirate's Den Guests Policy is as under:

- Members are to endorse and sign their own and guests presence in a register, placed at the entrance of Pirate's Den.
- A member has to book Pirate's Den Hall in advance, if wishing to bring-in more than 15 guests.
- A member can bring-in maximum of four guests excluding his own spouse or household member above the age of 18.
- In case a member brings in more than four guests, he will be charged Rs 2,000/- per head for additional number of guests (max up to 11 guests).
- If a member brings-in more than 15 guests, then member will be levied complete booking charges of Pirate's Den Hall irrespective of other members present in Pirate's Den or not.
