



DEFENCE AUTHORITY MARINA CLUB **NEWS BULLETIN – MAY 2026**

1. **Life Jackets.** Members are requested to ensure all personnel including tindals on-board while proceeding to sea must wear life jacket being a safety measure. In case of noncompliance Rs 2,000/- fine will be charged.
2. **Summers – 2026.** Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) is forecasting higher than usual temperatures during summers of 2026 throughout Pakistan. All members are requested to take precautionary measures against heat stroke and avoid physically strenuous work by their tindals during late mornings and afternoons.
3. **Permanent Membership.** After completion of 5 years of “Regular” membership a member may apply for permanent membership after depositing requisite fee after fulfilling certain conditions. A permanent member is entitled for certain advantages like eligibility for selection as a member of Club’s Executive Committee and privilege to “Propose” or “Second” candidates for membership of DAMC. Regular Members vying for Permanent Membership may apply in an early timeframe so that the cases can be processed in forthcoming Club Executive Committee Meeting.
4. **Billing Matters:**
 - a. Any member whose membership has been suspended for non-payment of his dues, may apply to the Secretary for reinstatement of his membership which may be granted provided such member first clears his dues in full and on reinstatement, pays his monthly subscription in full for the period his name remained struck off as an active member along with 15% financial penalty imposed by the Club.
 - b. Bills for subscription and expenses incurred by members shall be sent or presented to each member after the close of each month. In the event of a member failing to pay his bills within 2 months, he shall be reminded of the same by the Management and requested to pay within 10 days by registered letter. **Non receipt of bill by the member will not be accepted as an excuse.**
 - c. Any member failing to pay within the time specified and his/her outstanding dues exceeds 80% of security deposit may be deprived of the privileges of membership of the Club and his name may be displayed for suspension until payment is made in full.
 - d. Any member who has paid his bills by a cheque which has subsequently been returned by the Bank due to lack of funds, will have his membership suspended. The Club shall take appropriate action as it deems fit for recovery of dues from the Members.
